

Annual report 2016





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2016 has been an important year of consolidation for Musethica.

We have reached more than 13.000 people through 262 concerts, in cooperation with more than 100 social centres, representing our best numbers ever. Sixty-seven students and 21 teachers from 20 different countries have played in seven Musethica weeks, two International Festivals, and five editions of the Mastering Performance Program. We have reprised the beautiful experiences of our collaborations with the Gotland Chamber Music Festival in Sweden, the Upper Galilee Voice of Music Festival in Israel, and the Association L'amis de La Garde in Bourg-en-Bresse in France, and a new Musethica association has been established in Sweden. The Musethica Association is now present in five countries. Not everything has been a success; the Association in Poland, although still active, held no concerts this year. We will work hard to get it back into action in 2017.

Everything we do has a clear objective: to improve the teaching of classical music performance, while sharing our music with people who have difficultly accessing it. We found that evaluating the impact of our activities, both musically and socially, was a complex process if we wanted to do it in an objective manner. The Musethica Impact Evaluation, conducted by an external adviser, has confirmed that we are heading in the right direction, but has also given us some ideas to improve our impact and develop our project.

As in previous years, the cooperation of our sponsors has been both indispensable and essential. We are grateful for their support and generosity. We are especially grateful for the help of our volunteers and for the hard work of the members of the associations.

Finally, we want to acknowledge the labor and importance of the social centres that have been kind enough to let us cooperate with them. They are our mutual partners in our effort to make our lives more humane and meaningful. We thank them and you.

What is Musethica?

Concept

Musethica, an education program for talented young musicians, is a non-profit organisation that is active in, Germany, Israel, Poland, Spain and Sweden. It also has cooperating partners in China and France. The organisation represents a new model of integrating concert playing into musical education by bringing high-quality classical concerts out of concert halls and into society as a whole. The Musethica concept was the idea of violist Avri Levitan. Musethica was officially launched in 2012 in Zaragoza (Spain), under the auspices of Professor Carmen Marcuello.

The program offers a unique and global educational concept with the potential to bring about positive social change. Musethica provides qualified young artists the opportunity to perform concerts as part of their education. This characteristic is extremely valuable, as the art of playing concerts cannot be learned in a classroom; it must be learned in front of an audience.

Together with well-known musicians and professors, the students prepare concert programs of the highest quality. Teachers and students together play concerts for people who are excluded or at risk of exclusion in hospitals, refugee homes, homeless shelters, special schools and kindergartens, among others. They also play for the public in traditional concert halls.

The artistically and emotionally challenging practical concert training assists the musicians' development and encourages cultural participation in an open society. The music students develop a new understanding of music's meaning and of their role as professional musicians in society. It is important to highlight that all the musicians voluntarily participate in the concerts and receive no remuneration for them.

The non-profit organisation aims to integrate the Musethica model into the higher education system. By doing so, Musethica could bring additional concerts to people who would otherwise not be able to attend concerts. With a minimum of 100 Musethica concerts per school year, this model would provide more services than other conventional outreach programs for classical culture institutions.







EDUCATION PROGRAM

that introduces a new approach to teaching classical music performance within the higher education system. We understand that it is crucial for young musicians to play regularly in front of an audience. Therefore, Musethica provides a carefully selected group of young musicians the opportunity to perform concerts regularly as part of their education, sharing classical music with audiences that are normally not able to attend performances at concert halls; these concerts take place at different venues in the local community.

EXCELLENCE

We are committed to excellence and quality in the implementation of our activities, beginning with the selection of musical mentors and young musicians based on strict quality criteria. We treat each and every concert with the utmost respect and professionalism, whether it is played at a concert hall or elsewhere in the community. As we respect the music we play, we offer dignity to our various audiences. The repertoire is the same one would listen to at traditional concert halls and no changes are made based on the audience.

INCLUSION

Musethica works with excellent young musicians and inspires them with the idea that their excellence should reach society as a whole. In essence, we seek to transform the idea that excellence in youth education is only for the elite. We believe that excellence education only makes sense if it is accompanied by the inclusion of excellent young people from all realms of society. The social centres, their people and their work are our source of inspiration and the reason we seek to continually improve. We cooperate with them with the utmost respect. The role of social centres is fundamental, as they contribute to create our local roots. Their contributions allow us to exchange experiences and innovate collaboratively in teaching music as a universal language.

MUTUALISM

Musethica takes classical music from the concert halls into society as part of the musician's interests. All young musicians who participate in the Musethica program show an impressive progress in their abilities as instrumentalists and musicians. The beauty of the innovative approach of the program is that it serves both musicians and society. Regularly bringing classical music to different audiences is a wonderful social gift. It takes music back to its original mission. It allows a great number of people the opportunity, free of charge, to listen to live classical musical concerts at the highest level.

INNOVATION

We have developed a new teaching methodology in music, addressing the deficiencies of formal training and improving the quality of the teaching-learning process in musical higher education. We are open and eager to try new ways of collaborating, learning and teaching every day.

LOCAL-INTERNATIONALLY ORIENTED

A concert can be held only in a certain place at a certain moment, where musicians and audiences come together. But classical music is international and does not belong to anyone. Classical music has no boundaries. We encourage the international mobility of young musicians, improving their cultural and social awareness through activities with close local ties to social centres. Musethica includes a strong international dimension, notably in higher education and in the social field. Musethica is a capacity-building project promoting cooperation and partnership between the different Musethica associations that have an impact on the modernisation and internationalisation of higher education in classical music. Every Musethica Association brings added value to the project.



Objectives

- 1. Promoting an international change in educational programs for young outstanding musicians by integrating an important and crucial performance component to reinforce their studies, while giving them a chance to play with known musicians and professors.
- **2.** Supporting excellent young musicians' learning processes by providing them many concert opportunities at all levels of society to master the art of interpretation.
- **3.** Helping young musicians to understand what it means to be an excellent instrumentalist/ interpreter of classical music.
- **4.** Creating a new generation of young musicians that understands the importance of music in the community and in society.
- **5.** Promoting the professional development of young musicians by leveraging synergies between students and well-known professional musicians in order to improve competencies linked to their professional profiles.
- 6. Sharing classical music by playing concerts of the highest level in many social institutions for different kinds of audiences, specifically those who are socially excluded or at risk of exclusion because of personal difficulties (immigrants, people with disabilities, elderly people, etc.).
- 7. Creating synergies and building strategic partnerships between institutions in the classical music higher education system and social institutions with highquality teaching, training, learning and societal innovation.
- **8.** Spreading the Musethica education model and exploiting its results through collaboration with educational institutions all over the world.

Values

Respect. Each concert is treated with the utmost respect and professionalism, whether it is played in a concert hall or at any other place in the community. We offer the greatest dignity to the different audiences, just as we respect the music played. The repertoire is the same one would hear at traditional concert halls or music academies. No changes are made based on the audience.

Commitment. Musethica upholds a commitment to excellence and quality in the implementation of its activities, including its selection of musical mentors and young musicians.

Gratuity. The young musicians are selected for their instrumental and musical abilities and receive no financial compensation for their Musethica activities. The musical mentors are committed to participating in the program and interact with students in a professional manner. In this way, students become infused with their mentors' experiences and acquire the know-how of the best classical music professionals. Musical mentors receive financial compensation for classes and rehearsals, but not for concerts. The concerts in the social places are free for the centres and audiences.

Cooperation. We cooperate and coordinate with social centres, showing the utmost respect for their activities and features. The role of social centres in Musethica is fundamental, as they contribute the local fibre for the project. Individuals from the social centres are our source of inspiration and help us attain continual improvement. Their contributions allow us to exchange experiences and innovate collaboratively in the teaching of music as a universal language.

Transparency. We consider transparency to be a strong value for Musethica. We offer public information on all our activities, results and finances, and we also publish our external evaluation of the impact of our activities.







Activities in 2016

Education Activities

In 2016, Musethica developed the following education activities:

MUSETHICA WEEKS:

Musethica weeks are intensive training and concert weeks. Usually one week in duration, the training includes a small group of young musicians and chamber ensembles that intensively develops its performance skills. The young musicians receive master classes from Musethica mentors and perform between 10 and 15 concerts at social centres and public places during the week. Some concerts include both the young musicians and the musical mentors together. These concerts primarily occur at social centres, and some are open to the general public, performed at traditional concert halls, bars or open spaces. These open concerts have low entrance fees, and we make a point of inviting social centre collaborators. Local Musethica teams organize these concerts in collaboration with partners and social institutions.

During 2016, we conducted three Musethica Weeks in Germany; three in Spain; one in China; three in Israel and one in France.

MUSETHICA INTERNATIONAL CHAMBER MUSIC FESTIVALS:

The Musethica International Festivals of Chamber Music takes place over the course of a week with about 20 musicians taking part: internationally recognized musicians who serve as musical mentors and excellent young musicians. The festivals offer a wonderful experience combining music and social outreach. The first days of the festivals are dedicated to intensive rehearsals, some of which are open to the public. Then, morning and afternoon concerts are performed at different social centres in the city. During the last three days, three concerts open to the general public are offered in the afternoons. The total number of concerts varies between 20 and 28.

In 2016, we had the IV Musethica International Chamber Music Festival ($11^{th} - 18^{th}$ June) in Spain and the III Musethica International Chamber Music Festival (28^{th} October – 5^{th} November) in Israel.

FESTIVAL COLLABORATIONS:

Musethica collaborated with two prestigious festivals known as the Gotland Chamber Music Festival in Sweden ($24^{th} - 29^{th}$ July) and The Voice of Music in Upper Galilee Chamber Music Festival in Israel ($12^{th} - 16^{th}$ July). This was our second and third collaboration, respectively. Our model became part of the festivals. Young musicians were chosen to participate, master classes were held during the festivals, and many concerts were offered in social centers in addition to public concerts. Thus, the festivals reached a larger and more diverse audience while supporting excellent young artists. This year, we also participated in Musethica Journées Musicales de Bourg-en-Bresse in collaboration with L'Association Les Amis de La Garde, France ($17^{th} - 25^{th}$ September).

MUSETHICA MASTERING PERFORMANCE PROGRAM

In 2016, we have continued with the Mastering Performance Program, which started last year. We have collaborated with educational institutions in order to advance the concept of Musethica education and to introduce it to the realm of official musical education. The Musethica Mastering Performance Program is an education program open to excellent young musicians – individuals or chamber ensembles. These students will be offered the opportunity to take part in Musethica for a longer period of time. The program started in 2015–2016 in Israel and Spain.

The Musethica Israel String Quartet was established last November. The Musethica Israel Quartet members for 2016–17 are: Hallel Tutter, violin, Anna Seigreich, violin, Yoav Yatskan, viola, and Gali Knaani, cello. The Quartet studied on a regular basis with the violinist Alexander Pavlovsky. They have given community concerts regularly, and some public concerts in the second semester. Master classes with guest musicians were also held. All the classes and concerts are funded by Musethica Israel.

In Spain, the Mastering Performance Program offers residencies for young chamber music ensembles willing to intensively develop their ensembles. Selected musicians receive a full scholarship covering the study tuition fee and accommodation costs in Centro de Arte y Tecnología, Etopia Zaragoza, for a maximum period of seven months. The faculty for the Mastering Performance Program in Zaragoza includes musicians from the Musethica faculty and International Artistic Committee. After a national and international selection process, four quartets participated in two different moments during the year. The quartets were the Akilone Quartet, the Hanson Quartet, the Enea Quartet and the Gerhard Quartet.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

The Spanish association had its first open assembly in December. It was a moment of sharing experiences and ideas.



Concerts

Table 1 shows the total number of Musethica concerts in 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015. In 2015, the total number of concerts was 216. These concerts were distributed as follows: 7 in China, 11 in France, 37 in Germany, 52 in Israel, 21 in Poland 84 in Spain and 4 in Sweden. Compared to 2014, there was a significant increase in the number of concerts, from 184 to 216.

Repertoire

Musethica's repertoire forms an important and unique part of the concept. The art of choosing the repertoire strictly follows the protocol one would use when choosing a repertoire for playing at the Philharmonic Hall or any other concert hall for that matter. Musethica is a musical idea, and the musicians perform the repertoire they choose to learn and play. There is absolutely no special repertoire for "special" people. We discovered very quickly that when the music is played at the highest quality, the repertoire does not play a role. We play everything from Schubert or Tchaikovsky to Bach, for people aged 1 year old to 101, with no difference whatsoever. The musicians have to do their part by preparing the highest quality program and not bothering to "please" the audience with a special popular repertoire. Looking back, we noticed that what we were calling "complicated" pieces were the ones best received.

Volunteers

Furthermore, volunteers add a special dimension to Musethica's spirit. Musethica's work would be impossible without their cooperation. It is not possible to name all of them in this report, but we are deeply grateful to them.

Results and impacts

For any educational project, results and impact measurement is complex. We must be very careful when selecting indicators for both quantitative and qualitative aspects. Musethica's case is especially challenging because our main task is teaching musical interpretation, an artistic and subjective matter. This aspect makes measurement difficult. Also challenging to measure is the social nature of our activities and our goal of diffusing our model to educational institutions. Our organisation is still in the development phase, which also has to be taken into consideration when evaluating our impact. One of our future tasks is to develop a systematic process for evaluating Musethica's impact and to report the results in publications and presentations.



Organisational development

Musethica was created at the end of 2012 in Spain. Berlin's association emerged in 2013. In 2014, we created the Israel association and collaborated for the first time with China and for the second time with Poland, where Musethica was created officially in 2015. 2016 has seen the birth of the Swedish association.

The International Board and the International Artistic Committee are active and play an important role in the development of our project. Without these two teams, it would be impossible to reach so many different countries. Although there is still a lot of work to do, we are very satisfied with how Musethica has had a clear impact on the international level in very short period of time. Moreover, we should keep in mind that this development has always occurred in cooperation with local institutions as partners and more and more, the links between the local Musethica association and the local institutions, especially conservatories, are expected to give way to stable cooperation agreements which will lend extra support to our project, particularly in terms of international and official recognition.

Society

The beneficiaries of the project are users, staff members and families from social centres as well as the general audience attending Musethica public concerts.

We consider it relevant to describe the impact of live concerts on the different collectives of social centres. We are convinced that high-quality classical music in the form of live concerts affects the emotions and lives of audience members. Generally speaking, the audiences at the social centres are honest, sincere and exigent. They are not interested in the prestige of musicians or other laurels, only in the performance of the music. This is a real challenge because in these concerts, we face an honest and direct answer to our music, which makes the experience even more exciting, demanding and rewarding, greatly improving both our abilities and consciences as musicians.

Financial records

Income and Expenses 2016

The activities of Musethica are carried out very modestly with the help of collaborators and volunteers. The main expenditures for Musethica's activities include teachers' remunerations for master classes and logistics for Musethica's concerts and diffusion, including transport for musicians and instruments, food and lodging, copies of the scores, and communications and office materials, including our webpage. The concerts in the social centres are free, and the concerts in the traditional halls are free or nearly free. The young musicians do not receive any financial compensation, and they do not pay for the training program. The teachers do not receive remuneration for the concerts, but they are paid for master classes

The income from active associations in 2016 came from private donations, sponsors and public grants. The Musethica Week in China was funded through a collaboration with different institutions. The surplus of each association will be invested in association activities for 2016. In the case of Israel, the donations are for two years. Poland Association had no activity in 2016. The Sweden Association was created in 2016 and therefore has no data for 2015.
