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Letter from Carmen Marcuello and Avri Levitan

The years 2020 and 2021 were on one hand very difficult years for Musethica, as we had to cancel or repeatedly postpone many of the concerts in social institutions due to the corona pandemic. On the other hand, these years were particularly instructive and important for us, because we experienced that playing music in social institutions was specifically important for our audiences in these times: to some people it even became a ray of light. Especially in a time that is permeated by insecurities, fear of the future, isolation and loneliness, music is such a unifying element. That is why we are happy that we were still able to bring music to people who were particularly hard hit by the pandemic, even though we could play much less than hoped while taking all precautions.

The pandemic times were also very difficult for young musicians, as many of their commissions were canceled. It was all the more important for us to give as many of them the opportunity to perform in front of an audience, despite all the difficulties and challenges.

In 2020 - 2021, we were able to successfully run 52 Musethica sessions and 4 festivals with 677 concerts in 305 different social places in 9 countries. In 2021 we executed our first sessions in partnership with ECMA in Oslo and in The Hague. Musethica is an integral part of several ECMA sessions until 2024: at each session, two ensembles will take part in the Musethica training. Each ensemble has the opportunity to play between 10-14 concerts of solo and chamber music works. After two days of rehearsals and masterclasses, each ensemble plays concerts in different parts of the community: in social institutions such as hospitals, nurseries, schools for children with special needs, psychiatric institutions, refugee homes, homeless centers and prisons among many others.

For the second time Musethica was able to play a session in our new partnering city: Schleswig. The Musethica Session took place from September 6th to 10th, 2021 in Schleswig with the Callisto

Quartet (USA). With the support of the town of Schleswig, the cultural foundation of the district of Schleswig-Flensburg and the Schleswiger Werkstätten, 13 concerts were played in and around Schleswig-Flensburg. People were very pleased with the music - pieces by Johannes Brahms and Joseph Haydn - which was clearly noticeable in the warm applause and in the conversations between the musicians and the audience. A public concert that was opened with a greeting from the Mayor of Schleswig, Stephan Dose took place on Wednesday at the St. Johannis monastery.

We are very happy that Musethica was part of the Korsholm Music Festival in Finland in July 2021. The talented musicians Jonna Simonsson, Oskari Eirola, Elina Heikkinen and Liina-Mari Raivola performed a total of 13 concerts in kindergartens, prisons and care homes.

In November 2021, Musethica played its first concert in Genshagen at Kulturbrennerei Genshagen e.V. FreiRaum für die Künste with the Akhtamar Quartet.

In 2019, Musethica received a grant from the Neumayer Foundation, which supports Musethica in building, designing and establishing the first official Musethica University program together with the University of Music and Performing Arts Vienna (MDW). Starting in March 2020, formed string quartets can apply at MDW for a Musethica Postgraduate Program at MDW for the first time. From Wintersemester 2020 Musethica will also be available for Master Students of the MDW. This is an important step in the development of Musethica and will hopefully open a new horizon in music education for interpretation around the world.

We want to thank our sponsors and our cooperation partners, whose support has been both indispensable and essential. We are grateful for their support and generosity. We are especially thankful for the help of our volunteers and for the hard work of the members of the associations.

Finally, we want to acknowledge the labor and importance of the social centers that have been kind enough to let us cooperate with them even in times of such big insecurities. They are our mutual partners in our effort to make our lives more humane and meaningful. We thank them and you.

What is Musethica?

An education program for musicians with social impact

Musethica is an educational method for talented musicians, introducing extensive concert performances to a wide range of audiences as a basic teaching tool. Selected musicians are given the opportunity to perform a large number of concerts as a fundamental part of their education, often playing together with their mentor. Musethica's international team of experienced and carefully chosen mentors coach the musicians in masterclasses and rehearsals, preparing concert programs of the highest quality. The mentor attends all concerts and coaches the musicians after each concert. Together, the young musicians and their mentors perform extensively to all parts of society. At least 85 percent of the concerts are performed outside traditional concert halls. Musethica's concerts are played in prisons, schools, kindergartens, hospitals, elderly homes, homeless shelters, centers for special education, and in many other unusual places. The aim is to play for all parts of society, prioritizing people who are excluded or at risk of exclusion. The concerts are always free of charge. Musicians and their mentors perform without remuneration. The aim of Musethica is to establish itself as a program of excellence and as an integrated part of the higher education in music universities and conservatories worldwide.

How can we teach inspiration?

Musethica was born of the dire need for musicians to play regularly in front of an audience - an aspect of musical training that has traditionally been paid scant attention. The musician functions as a bridge between a musical composition and the listener. It is an art that cannot solely be learned in the classroom. To completely master their instruments, musicians need these encounters with audiences. The intensive Musethica training program is an enormous challenge for musicians but also brings moving moments. During the one-week sessions, the musicians play an average of 12 to 14 concerts, often surpassing even their expectations of themselves. Freed from the competitive daily atmosphere at academic institutions, the musicians are able to improve their concentration, enhance their performance and learn to listen to themselves and each other. Whether it be a performance in a concert hall or in a kindergarten, the same repertoire is played regardless. Concerts are played in all settings with the same respect and high standards. The repertoire is not adjusted to the audience and no explanation is needed. The music speaks for itself. After each concert, there is time for a dialogue between the audience and the musicians.

Musical quality

It is through the quality of the music that Musethica's concept derives its social impact. Experience shows that there is a strong correlation between the quality of the performance and the attentiveness of the audience.

Before participating in Musethica, musicians undergo an application process in which they are selected by Musethica's International Artistic Committee. As part of each Musethica Session, the participants prepare concert programs in masterclasses, which they then go on to perform many times for all sorts of people, together with tutors, renowned soloists and teachers at music academies from around the world. By taking part in the training program, the young musicians make remarkable progress in a very short time. They improve their intuitive playing and learn how to communicate through music.

Learning from the audience

A special role in this process is played by the unusual audiences in social centers. Senior citizens, children and people with physical or mental disabilities often show their emotional reactions to the music – in both positive and negative ways – completely free of conventions. This direct response from the audience is a rare experience for the young musicians, one they normally don't experience in music schools and concert halls. This is what opens up a whole new perspective on their role as musicians and their important social function.

Each local community and city in which the Musethica program is active receives up to 100 free concerts per year. When establishing and integrating Musethica in the curriculum of the academic program, social concerts will be an inseparable part of the musician's life and society.



Objectives

- 1. To implement our method of teaching music interpretation.
- 2. To integrate the Musethica model into the higher education system and spread it through collaboration to interested education institutions anywhere in the world.
- 3. To share music and its creative powers, especially with those who have no easy access to it and above all with those socially excluded or at risk of being excluded.
- 4. To support the learning process of young musicians, improving their instrumental abilities and mastering the art of performance, playing a large number of concerts in cooperation with experienced and selected mentors for all kinds of audiences.
- 5. To provide musicians and their teachers opportunities for developing a deeper understanding of what being an excellent musician means and the importance of music for the community and society.
- 6. To create synergies and build strategic partnerships among institutions in the classical music higher education system and social institutions.
- 7. To offer musicians the opportunity to be part of an international and social network that promotes them as professional musicians.
- 8. To communicate and disseminate the Musethica educational model in cooperation with educational and research institutions.

Values

Cooperation. Social centers are fundamental to Musethica's approach, as they represent the local fiber for the project. Individuals from the social centers are our source of inspiration and help us attain continual improvement. Their contributions allow us to exchange experiences and innovate collaboratively in the teaching of music as a universal language.

Respect. Concerts are treated with the utmost respect and professionalism, whether in a concert hall or at any other place in the community. The repertoire is the same as one would hear in traditional concert halls or music academies, without making any special allowances for the particular audience.

Quality. Musethica is committed to quality and excellence in implementing its concept and activities, primarily in the selection of musical mentors and young musicians and in the process of preparation. This commitment begins with selecting musical mentors and young musicians strictly based on the quality of their playing, regardless of gender, race, age, sexual orientation, etc.

Accessibility. The young musicians are selected from applicants for their instrumental and musical abilities and are not paid for what is a key part of their musical education. The musical mentors are committed to participating in the program and interact with students in a professional manner. The musical mentors are paid for their teaching but not for concerts. The social center concerts are always free, for centers and audiences.

Mutualism. We seek to generate interactions and synergies among cultural, creative, educational, and social services institutions. We try to build strategic partnerships that strengthen cooperation between classical

music, education, and the social sphere. We find a great source of inspiration in finding new ways of free cooperation that benefit all parties involved.

Inclusion. The social centers, their people and their work are our source of inspiration and the reason we seek to continually improve. We cooperate with them with the utmost respect. The role of social centers is fundamental, as they contribute to creating our local roots. Their contributions allow us to exchange experiences and innovate collaboratively in the process of learning of our young musicians. Musicians learn at Musethica that they are part of society and not a small exclusive group. They understand that they, as musicians, have an important function and develop the ability to communicate with any audience through music, humanely and socially.

Transparency. We consider transparency to be a strong value for Musethica. We offer public information about all our activities, results and finances; and we also publicize the external impact evaluation of the activities.

Formats in 2020 and 2021

Musethica Sessions

Musethica sessions are one-week workshops that include rehearsals, master classes and concert playing. A small group of musicians or a chamber ensemble selected by Musethica's International Artistic Committee gets the opportunity to intensively develop their performance skills. After preparation days, the musicians perform 2-3 concerts over the day at social centers and public places. Young musicians and their musical mentors perform together. The concerts in social centers are offered free of charge, Local Musethica teams organize the concerts in collaboration with educational partners and social institutions.

In 2020, we conducted 19 Musethica Sessions in Germany, Israel, Sweden, France and Spain.

In 2021, 29 Musethica Sessions took place in Poland, Norway, The Netherlands, Israel, Germany, Spain, France and Finland.

Musethica International Chamber Music Festivals

Musethica's International Festivals of Chamber Music takes place over the course of a week. Usually, a group of 14 musicians is taking part: 4 internationally recognized musicians who serve as musical mentors and 10 excellent young musicians from different countries. After two days of rehearsing, the young musicians together with two public concerts taking place at traditional concert venues. The total number of concerts played in one festival varies between 20 and 28. The festival offers a wonderful experience combining music and social outreach.

We are pleased that despite the pandemic in 2020, the Berlin Festival could take place under the strictest observance of hygiene regulations. Unfortunately, the festivals in Spain and Israel had to be canceled.

In 2021, we happily realized a total of 3 festivals in Spain, Israel and Germany.

Postgraduate study programme at the University of Music and performing Arts Vienna

For the first time, the Musethica programme, which enables young, selected musicians of the highest profile to perform a large number of concerts in social contexts with diverse audiences, has become the main component of their academic achievements: 100 concerts in 2 years for the postgraduate degree. This is not only to give them the opportunity to improve their musical skills, but also to create an awareness of the social approach they can take as musicians and what music can achieve in a society.

With the implementation of the Musethica method in the curriculum, the MDW is an example for other music universities in the world and shows how this integration can be carried out on a bureaucratic and practical level.

Our common idea together with the NEUMAYER STIFTUNG was and is to give the Musethica-method an independent and sustainable future in the academic world.

The MDW opened the official selection process for string quartets (later other ensembles can also apply) to participate in the Musethica programme from the Summer semester 2020. The quartet selected to participate in the programme is the internationally acclaimed Callisto Quartet from the USA (1st prize Banff Competition and other international competitions). Due to the corona pandemic, the programme with the Callisto Quartet could not start in 2020 as planned, but had to be postponed to 2022.

Festival Collaborations

Musethica collaborates with prestigious festivals in different countries: the Gotland Chamber Music Festival in Sweden, The Voice of Music in Upper Gailee Chamber Music Festival in Israel, the Zeist Music Days in Holland as well as the Korsholm Music Festival in Finland. As part of those festivals, selected young musicians receive master classes and play concerts in social centers, in addition to public concerts at festival venues. By making Musethica part of those festivals the festivals reach a larger and more diverse audience while supporting excellent young artists.

ECMA Pro / Musethica Sessions

ECMA Pro was proposed by the members and cooperating partners of the European Chamber Music Academy – ECMA. ECMA is a network of music universities and festivals aimed at supporting young chamber music ensembles by offering regular international coaching sessions. The project was conceived after an extensive analysis of the situation, needs and challenges of the environment and target groups in chamber music in 2019, i.e. before the onset of the pandemic. The consortium aimed to enhance the then existing format of the ECMA sessions by including new components involving partners from the music profession and focusing on new aspects.

The project started in September 2020, when the pandemic was still in full swing; but also now, two years into the project period and with the post-pandemic music business taking shape, the general observations in the project application remain valid and have been addressed by the project so far:

• Also after the pandemic, the quality of chamber music ensembles remains on a high level, which is i.e. visible in the high interest of young ensembles to apply for participation in

ECMA and the quality and number of ensembles that were admitted to ECMA during the project period, especially in recent months.

- This also provides proof of the ongoing interest of young musicians to build chamber music ensembles as part of their "portfolio careers".
- Chamber music ensembles during the pandemic proved to be a sustainable format. Groups were booked relatively regularly and in a relatively large variety of event locations, precisely because of their manageable size especially in comparison with larger formats such as orchestras. This trend has remained well into the post-pandemic music business, as audiences are even more enclined towards smaller, more intimate and individual performance situations.
- Digital distribution in all areas of music making from dissemination of artistic content to marketing and booking has skyrocketed since the onset of the pandemic, a trend which also is highly likely to consolidate in the current and future music realm.
- Other than before the pandemic, and along with rising awareness to address climate change in the music business, ensembles as well as audiences and event organizers have discovered the importance of a more national and regional approach to concert programming, in addition to an international career perspective.
- All these and further recent developments in the music industry show the necessity for young musicians to be well prepared in fields beyond the strictly artistic excellence, such as the development of career skills, including an international perspective, digital distribution methods as well as innovative performance formats and approaches to socially engaged outreach.

As outlined in the project application, the project has addressed all these aspects in its implementation and further developed the original ideas and concepts in the process, as will be shown in the interim project report. The impact of the project is visible already now on various levels. The quality of ECMA sessions, with respect to topics such as career development and reflection on new performance formats, has improved considerably – as has the interest of ensembles to attend the trainings provided in these fields. This rising interest and awareness is also visible in the ensembles' more elaborate, more reflected application texts for the trainings. As mentioned above, the overall interest with young ensembles to participate in ECMA has increased significantly, which can at least in part be attributed to the additional opportunities the project provides. A change to a more entrepreneurial mindset and behavior and awareness of the necessity of engaging with career management issues is visible in many young ensembles and individual musicians and especially their marketing activities.

After some initial, already well attended showcase concerts, the formats, repertoires and target audiences of ECMA showcases are being further developed and expanded, which can be attributed to the increased preoccupation with innovative concert and outreach formats by the ensembles themselves; and as the ECMA partners expand their outreach, developing new ways to engage with the public and to reach new audiences.

Along with Musethica sessions that provide the opportunity for outreach to social groups usually not likely to be present at classical concerts, the participating students express their awareness of the social dimension of their work and their social responsibility as artists. This broadening of their social perspectives also increases job opportunities as they become aware of hitherto not explored target audiences and fields of activity. The Musethica sessions in Oslo, The Hague and Vilnius also gave the organizing partners a possibility to expand their organizations' activities to further social organizations and increase their outreach activities.

The ongoing development of the three online platforms has, together with intense discussions on structure, concrete content and target audiences and technical implementation, increased the expertise of project partners considerably; at the same time, increased digitisation of the field of

chamber music can be seen in the partly hybrid implementation of ECMA sessions as well as the positive response to these opportunities by the ensembles.

Musethica Open Masterclasses: "The Art of Listening"

The Musethica idea and method was created with the understanding that musicians should learn from their listeners. That led to the idea of developing an additional activity as part of the Musethica program: conducting lessons and rehearsals in front of children, whose direct support and involvement creates great benefit for both sides.

In 2019, we did a few trials in the psychiatric department for children in the DRK (German Red Cross) hospital in Berlin as well as in the youth prison of Berlin. These trials had a fantastic effect on the children and caused enthusiastic reactions from their teachers and therapists, which motivated us to take it forward and make it accessible to more children from different backgrounds.

In 2019, we successfully applied for the Creative Europe Call "Music education and learning" with our pilot "The Art of Listening", which gave us the opportunity to realize more than 40 masterclasses in different schools in Berlin (Germany), Zaragoza (Spain) and Bourg-en-Bresse (France). This pilot aims to test new learning opportunities and explore new cooperation modalities between excellent music professionals and different types of educational institutions targeting disadvantaged children from 6 to 14 years of age.

Selected, advanced musicians who study at the most prestigious music academies and universities of Europe will receive a public lesson by a tutor in front of small groups of children who will be active participants in the lesson. Children will actively take part and contribute to these master classes, bringing their perception of music into the lessons.

Despite significant restrictions during the corona pandemic, by the end of 2021, we have already been able to implement 21 master classes with 32 young musicians and 8 different tutors in 9

venues. We are looking forward to continuing the project with around 20 more Masterclasses until May 2022.

Repertoire

Musethica's repertoire forms an important and unique part of the concept. The art of choosing the repertoire strictly follows the protocol one would use when choosing a repertoire for playing at the Philharmonic Hall or any other concert hall for that matter.

Musethica is a musical idea, and the musicians perform the repertoire they choose to learn and play. There is absolutely no special repertoire for "special" people. We discovered very quickly that when the music is played at the highest quality, the repertoire does not play a role. We play everything from Schubert or Tchaikovsky to Bach, for people aged 1 year old to 101, with no difference whatsoever.

The musicians have to do their part by preparing the highest quality program and not bothering to "please" the audience with a special popular repertoire. Looking back, we noticed that what we were calling "complicated" pieces were the ones best received.

In the following table, we present the repertoire for 2020 and 21.

Furthermore, volunteers add a special dimension to Musethica's spirit. Moved by the wish to help and the love of music, while receiving no financial compensation for their efforts, they provide invaluable help with logistics and coordination. Musethica's work would be impossible without their cooperation. It is not possible to name all of them in this report, but we are deeply grateful for their help and support.

Results and impact

For any educational project, results and impact measurement is complex. We must be very careful when selecting indicators for both quantitative and qualitative aspects. Musethica's case is especially challenging because our main task is teaching musical interpretation, an artistic and subjective matter. This aspect makes measurement difficult. Also challenging to measure is the social nature of our activities and our goal of diffusing our model to educational institutions. Our organization is still in the development phase, which also has to be taken into consideration when evaluating our impact. We have developed a systematic evaluation form that can capture the experiences of the participating musicians and the impact of Musethica's activities. We designed questionnaires for different target groups (Musicians, audience in social places, caretakers). Below follows a selection of feedback from musicians and workers of social institutions that we visit regularly. Furthermore, Social Impact Evaluation Reports from past years are available on our website.

Feedback about Musethica 2020 - 2021

Cecilia Zilliacus, violinist, artistic director of Katrina Chamber Music on Åland as well as of the Korsholm Music Festival in Finland:

"Some of the most memorable moments of my musical life took place during concerts during a Musethica session. It is indeed very special to so obviously experience how strong the power of music can be – severely brain-damaged children who normally can not sit still and be quiet for more than one or two minutes gave us their attention for almost 30 minutes, listening to Arnold Schönberg's "Verklärte Nacht" – this is only one out of many examples. As artistic director of the Korsholm Music Festival in Vaasa, Finland, it felt highly relevant to give young and talented musicians, as well as many social institutions and concert-goers in the Vaasa area, a possibility to benefit from the Musethica concept. In 2019, when Musethica's first session in Vaasa took place, the festival theme was "Sic Vita!". This theme specifically focused on different fates and stages in life – one can get sick or imprisoned, you are a child or you are old. No matter where in life you are – music is an important force. Musethica helps making this force accessible to people in various life situations.

For us musicians, both students and teachers, the Musethica concept gives many valuable opportunities to perform important chamber music and solo works in different environments.

It gives the audiences, all with different experiences of listening to classical music, access to high quality live performances in their own surroundings – day care centers or prisons turned into concert venues, all with varying acoustics and sizes.

This is a wonderful challenge to musicians to both stay focused on the performance and share the music – our most important job!"

Johannes Meissl, violinist, Vice rector for International Affairs and Art, University of Music and Performing Arts, Vienna:

"Establishing Musethica at MDW – University of Music and Performing Arts Vienna started in 2017 with a first session, and supported by the Neumayer Stiftung and thanks to the commitment of the Joseph Haydn Department and especially Mara Földi it has been possible to start the process of integration of the activities within MDW. Musethica has the potential to become one of the important projects in the near future for MDW, in full accordance with the university's goals in community engagement, quality enhancement and sustainability.

What will be decisive for MDW is to secure sufficient and sustainable external funding to ensure the required administrative support for developing the project further.

My long term vision for Musethica in Austria is to connect the project more and more to public bodies, and by that both enlarge the access to high class musical performance for

all members of society and extend the working possibilities for musicians.

The staff watched the magic with moist eyes. The young and gifted music students who came to play, almost as young as our older students, were sitting very close to the kids and created with them an experience that touched the kids' hearts and souls, allowing each of them to connect in their own way to this deep, elating emotional experience, through the language of music that is beyond words and beyond the differences that separate us."

Roni Sherrer- Eldar, whose son attends the Kshatot Center School in Sha'ar Menashe:

"For one defining moment they were as one in the musical experience – the musicians, the staff and the students. Under the umbrella of sounds, an unmediated connection of everyone present. As a mother whose son has been diagnosed on the autistic spectrum and attends the Kshatot School, I strive to provide for my son the enriching experience of music and theater and other performing arts, which he is currently not able to enjoy with the general public. Musethica musicians played at my son's school, and it is hard to describe the magic that took place in that room that morning, from the moment the string instruments started to play."

Friedrich von Kirchbach, La Garde, Bourg-en-Bresse:

"Most touching has been to experience the ability of Musethica to make the magic of music actually happen, and, what is more, under quite unlikely circumstances. During most of the concerts in social centers, the audience is not at all familiar with the composers, their music, nor even the classical instruments. Everything is new and – at first sight – a bit off-putting. Yet, the quality of the music and the musicians invariably transforms the audience. Listeners are lifted up and brought closer to themselves. Hearing and watching the musicians from close by is always a unique experience: witnessing how the long years of practice enables them to give their very best, to transcend individuality, to merge with the composition and the other musicians, and to create jointly something that directly touches the hearts of the audience. This becomes tangible in the reactions of listeners of all generations, all social backgrounds, and often quite unfamiliar with classical music.

Musethica's recipe for success seems to be the magic mix of the excellence of experienced teachers, the passion and joy of young musicians who want to learn, the depth and beauty of the pieces played, and the transformation of audiences grappling with some of the most difficult aspects of the human condition."

Organizational development

Musethica was founded in 2012 in Zaragoza, Spain by viola player Avri Levitan and economics professor Carmen Marcuello.

The Berlin association emerged in 2013. In 2014, the Israel association was created. In 2014, Musethica also started a collaboration with the Forbidden City Concert Hall in Beijing, China. In 2015, a Musethica association was founded in Poland and Musethica collaborated for the first time with Le Domaine de la Garde in Bourg-en-Bresse, France under the guidance of Friedrich von Kirchbach. In 2016, the Swedish association was born. In 2018, a first cooperation with Zeist Music Days in Holland was established and in 2019, Musethica was part of the Korsholm Festival in Finland. Since the first Musethica Session in Oslo in 2020, Musethica is active in 11 countries:

Germany, Spain, Sweden, Israel, Poland, France, China, Austria, The Netherlands, Finland and Norway. Poland

The International Board and the International Artistic Committee play an important role in the development of our project. The first international application process for Musethica activities was carried through in 2019. Young musicians who were interested in participating in Musethica activities had to fill an online application form, providing Musethica with audio and video recordings of their playing.

Each applicant was reviewed by two members of the artistic committee. Approved candidates were distributed among Musethica Sessions in different countries. The number of approved applicants was higher than available places in activities.

Without these two teams, it would be impossible to reach so many different countries. Although there is still a lot of work to do, we are very satisfied with how Musethica has had a clear impact on the international level in a very short period of time. Moreover, we should keep in mind that this development has always occurred in cooperation with local institutions as partners and more, the links between the local Musethica association and the local institutions. Especially conservatories are expected to give way to stable cooperation agreements which will lend extra support to our project, particularly in terms of international and official recognition.

In 2019, Musethica received a grant from the Neumayer Foundation which supports Musethica in building, designing and establishing the first official Musethica University program together with the University of Music and Performing Arts Vienna (MDW). Starting in March 2020 formed string quartets can apply at MDW for a Musethica Postgraduate Program at MDW for the first time. From Wintersemester 2020 Musethica will also be available for Master Students of the MDW. This is an important step in the development of Musethica and will hopefully open a new horizon in music education for interpretation around the world.

Society

The beneficiaries of the project are users, staff members and families from social centers as well as the general audience attending Musethica public concerts. We consider it relevant to describe the impact of live concerts on the different collectives of social centers. We are convinced that high-quality classical music in the form of live concerts affects the emotions and lives of audience members. Generally speaking, the audiences at the social centers are honest, sincere and exigent. They are not interested in the prestige of musicians or other laurels, only in the performance of the music. This is a real challenge because in these concerts, we face an honest and direct answer to our music, which makes the experience even more exciting, demanding and rewarding, greatly improving both our abilities and consciences as musicians.

The activities of Musethica are carried out very modestly with the help of collaborators and volunteers. The main expenditures for Musethica's activities include teachers' remunerations for master classes and logistics for Musethica's concerts and diffusion, including transport for musicians and instruments, food and lodging, copies of the scores, and communications and office materials, including our webpage. The concerts in the social centers are free, and the concerts in the traditional halls are free or nearly free. The young musicians do not receive any financial compensation, and they do not pay for the training program. The teachers do not receive remuneration for the concerts, but they are paid for master classes.
